DECLARATION OF GORDON P. ERSPAMER IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE THIRD AMENDED COMPLAINT - Case No. CV 09-0037-CW sf-2850531

I, Gordon P. Erspamer, declare as follows:

- 1. I am an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of California and am admitted to practice before this Court. I am a senior counsel with the law firm of Morrison & Foerster LLP, counsel of record for Vietnam Veterans of America, Swords to Plowshares: Veterans Rights Organization, Bruce Price, Franklin D. Rochelle, Larry Meirow, Eric P. Muth, David C. Dufrane and Wray C. Forrest ("Plaintiffs") in this action. I submit this Declaration in Support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to File a Third Amended Complaint. I make this Declaration based on personal knowledge. If called as a witness, I would testify to the facts set forth below.
- 2. On information and belief, William Blazinski was an experimental test subject at Edgewood Arsenal.
- 3. On information and belief, Tim Michael Josephs was an experimental test subject at Edgewood Arsenal.
- 4. Plaintiffs' counsel have identified information in discovery indicating that the Department of Veterans Affairs ("DVA") provided chemicals and drugs for experiments to be conducted at Edgewood Arsenal and other sites, that the DVA has assumed responsibility for notifying participants in the experiments, that the scope of the notices being sent is inadequate and too narrow, and has circulated what Plaintiffs believe is false or misleading information to veterans, and that the DVA was involved in experimental testing of many of the same biological and chemical substances tested upon military personnel at Edgewood.
- 5. On information and belief, Plaintiff Wray Forrest is in poor health and not expected to live beyond a few months or weeks.
- 6. During a May 19, 2010 telephone conference, Defendants' counsel asked Plaintiffs' counsel whether Plaintiffs intended to amend their complaint in the near future. Counsel for Plaintiffs responded that Plaintiffs would be seeking to amend the complaint shortly to add two or three new plaintiffs, and possibly to add additional parties.
- 7. Plaintiffs' counsel gave Defendants' counsel the proposed amendment sections regarding Mr. Josephs and Mr. Blazinski on June 2, 2010, and asked Defendants' counsel to stipulate, even in part, to Plaintiffs' amendments.
