overruling objections and ordering the CIA to designate witnesses to testify regarding many of
Plaintiffs' initial Rule 30(b)(6) Notice topics (see Docket No. 178 ("Nov. 2010 Order") at 18-29).
The CIA's discovery recalcitrance and continuing failure to comply with this Court's discovery
orders require that fact discovery of the CIA be permitted to continue until 30 days following the
CIA's compliance with all outstanding discovery obligations, including any discovery compelled
by the Court's resolution of Plaintiffs' accompanying Motion to Compel.
